Step



Power to the Module




Step 1



Placement of the module should be 2' from any metal wall or surface. Power up the unit using the 12V (3.3A) Power Supply. Connect the female plug into the power supply and plug into the outlet. A blue light on top of the unit illuminates when the unit is ON.

Warning Module to Module



Connect Warning Module (male) to Module (female).

Adjusting the Module



Remove the cover to the Module using an appropriate Phillips head screwdriver. The unit will need to remain plugged in while making the adjustments.

Adjusting the Module (Cont.)

All adjustments in Step 4 needs to be done by a professional



- To adjust the field size use a 3/32" flathead screwdriver.
- Place the PAD just *inside* the area you want the field to reach to. **SLOWLY** rotate the pot "PWM" clockwise to increase the area and counterclockwise to decrease the area. Be careful to not over rotate the pot.
- Turn the pot until the PAD sounds. There will be about a 1 second delay.


Alerting Signals

PAD (Pedestrian Alert)

- Warning Zone- Series of 3 beeps
- Danger Zone- Continuous signal

To check the PAD, move the PAD from outside of the to Warning Zone to the Danger Zone. Verify the transitions occur at the proper distances.

Factory Standard Field Size 12V Warning: 12ft Danger: 8ft



Functionality of the PDTEST



When a PAD enters the **Warning Zone:**

The Warning Module will flash in series of 3 blinks.

When a PAD enters the **Danger Zone:**

The Warning Module will be continously lit.

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
