



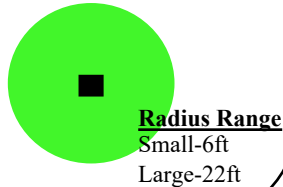
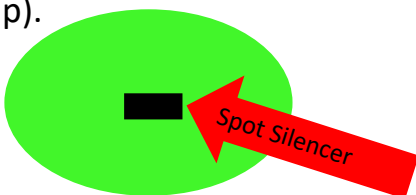
DDAC Spot Silencer (SpotZ) Installation Guide

Size of Magnetic Field

The radius of the field can be adjusted from 6' (circular) to 22' (rectangular). The magnetic field is elliptical and will go through walls. **Placement is critical and should not extend outside of the safe location and in the path of a lift truck.** The field can be circular if the RMSZ is placed vertically (long side pointed up).

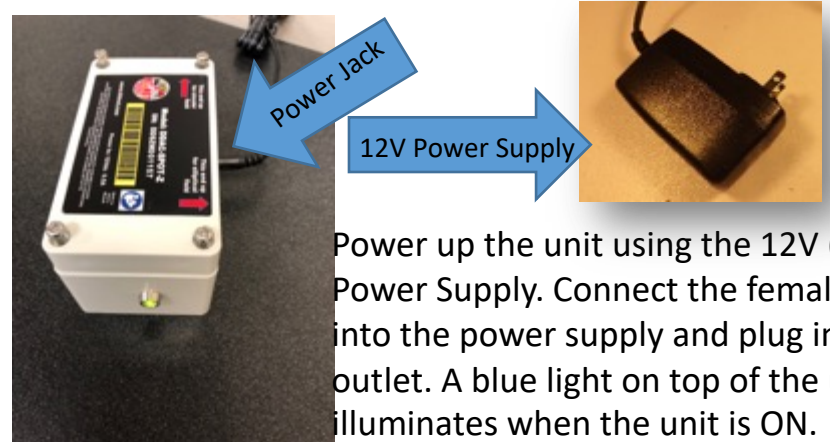

Step 1

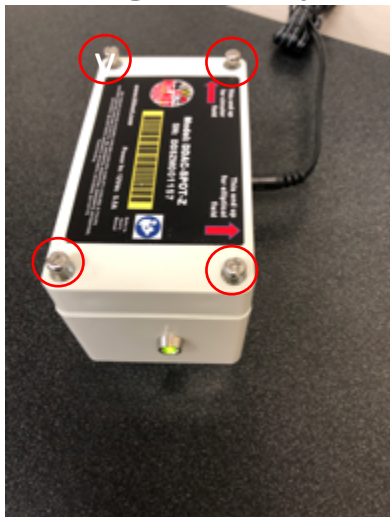
Power to Spot Silencer



Power up the unit using the 12V (3.3A) Power Supply. Connect the female plug into the power supply and plug into the outlet. A blue light on top of the unit illuminates when the unit is ON.

Step 2

Adjusting the Spot Silencer



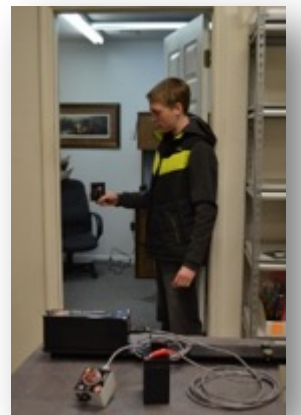
Remove the cover to the Spot Silencer using an appropriate Phillips head screwdriver. **The unit will need to remain plugged in while making the adjustments.**

Step 3

Adjusting the Spot Silencer II

All adjustments in Steps 4-6 need to be done by a professional.

- To check the field size, position a generator with a battery connection just outside the office (or a fork lift with a generator).
- To determine the size of the silent zone, walk from inside the office to the outside with a PAD to determine where it starts to sound. That is the size of the current silent zone.



Step 4

Adjusting the Spot Silencer III



- To adjust the field size use a 3/32" flathead screwdriver.
- Place the PAD just **inside** the area you want to silence.
- SLOWLY rotate the pot "PWM" clockwise to increase the area and counterclockwise to decrease the area. Be careful to not over rotate the pot.
- Turn the pot until the PAD sounds. There will be about a 1 second delay.

Step 5

Adjusting the Spot Silencer IV



- If the Silent Zone is not silencing the PAD consistently, Set Silencer to "JAMMER" mode: Turn Switch 1 OFF. **Factory setting is ON**
- To adjust field range, use Switch 2. **Turn Switch 2 ON for full field.** OFF will limit maximum size of field.

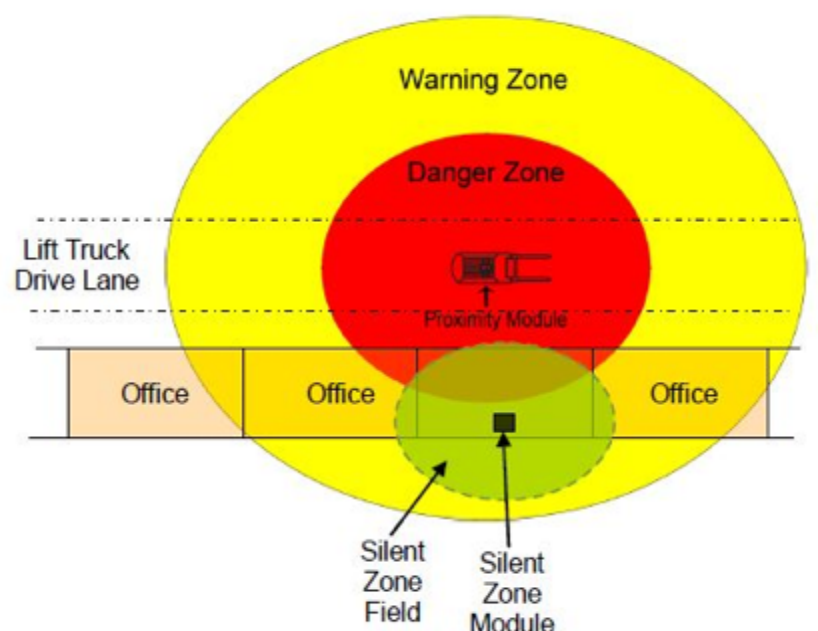
Step 6

Adjusting the Spot Silencer V

- Check all areas surrounding the unit to make sure a truck path does not travel through the silent zone.
- Replace the cover
- To disconnect the unit, unplug it from the wall. There is no power switch.**
