

# **BUMP CAP PAD** Installation Guide (For Units with Serial # PAxxxx)

# **STEPS FOR BUMP CAP PAD INSTALLATION**

### **STEP 1: Charging Instructions/Maintenance**

### ▲ Fully Charge PAD Before Use.

### ▲ Fully Charge Daily.

A PAD should be **tested daily**, using accessory devices such as the PAD Quick Check, Integrated Check Out Station, or Access Monitor.

### **MUST lift the flap of the pouch or vest to charge PAD!**

- 1. Plug the USB side of the magnetic charging cord into the USB wall adaptor provided. **(Fig. 1)**
- 2. Plug the magnetic charging connector into the charge port on the PAD. (It will only go one way).
- 3. The LED light on the PAD will turn solid **blue** when the PAD is charging.
- 4. The LED light will turn solid **orange** when the PAD is fully charged.
- 5. Once charged, remove the magnetic charging cord, the LED light will turn OFF and the sounder will sound alert for two seconds.

▲ Make sure the PAD is connected to the charger over the weekend and holidays. Battery should Only be replaced by trained personnel. It is best practice to replace battery yearly.
▲ Note: If the LED charge light flashes blue erratically when charger is connected and does not turn orange, ensure the charger cable and charger port on Bump Cap is clear of any debris. If the LED charge light does NOT come on when connected to the magnetic charger and/or the Blue light does NOT change colors after 6 hours of continuous charging, ensure the battery is plugged in. If it is, replace the battery.





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### **STEP 2: Attachment to Bump Cap**

- a. The PAD should be placed on the BACK of the BUMP CAP as shown below. It is best practice to use the double sided Velcro supplied. (Fig. 2)
- ▲ DO NOT MAKE ANY STRUCTURE ALTERATIONS TO THE BUMP CAP WHEN ATTACHING THE PAD.
- b. The PAD Sounder should be placed on the Brim of the BUMP CAP as shown below. It is best practice to use the clip that is supplied for this attachment. **(Fig. 3)**

## **STEP 3: Zones of Protection**

The PAD detects the magnetic field in two zones: Warning (Yellow) and Danger (Red). A Pedestrian will see and hear a series of **3 beeps in the Warning Zone** and a continuous signal for the Danger Zone. (Fig. 4)

### **STEP 4: Low Battery Warning**

A When the battery is LOW, the user will hear a series of 2 rapid beeps. The user must **IMMEDIATELY** recharge the PAD battery.

- **M** When the PAD is in Low Battery mode the user will cease to be given zone warnings!
- ▲ CHARGE PAD IMMEDIATELY!
